<u>Reading</u>

Please continue to encourage your child to read 3 times a week, as this will really support their development in every aspect of the school curriculum. 5-10 mins a night is perfect. Please continue to sign their reading record books at least 3 times a week so they are able to participate in the class reading raffle.

English:

Children are making good progress within phonics and their reading groups. We will continue to work with them in small phonics/reading groups. Year 1 will be doing the phonics screening check in June. You will be informed of these results in your reports. This will be completed by Miss Loynes on a one to one basis. The children are used to reading phonemes and words when we assess them most half terms for Read Write Inc. groups so this process should not worry them.

We will be doing writing units on biography's, writing letters and report writing. We are working on building up their stamina in writing their own sentences independently using correct punctuation. As a whole class we will read and do some experience days based on the book "Can I be your Dog? By Troy Cummings.
