We're open to all suggestions! Whether it's a game, activity, or unique way to entertain the crowds — let's make this a day that everyone can enjoy!





What do we spend our funds on?

The purpose of the PTA is to create and enhance the opportunities for every child and to strengthen our connection with the community.

Your elected committee carefully decides how the money we raise is spent, ensuring that every penny goes directly back into supporting the school.

Here's how your support helps:

- £250 is allocated to each class to spend often used towards trips and enrichment opportunities.
- Christmas gifts are purchased to help Santa deliver presents to our KS1 and Early Years children.
- Christingle oranges and decorations are funded for our festive celebrations.
- Year 6 pupils receive a small token gift as a farewell.

We also maintain a savings fund for bigger, long-term projects.

A few years ago, we asked the children what they felt would improve their school experience. Thanks to your support and successful charity fundraising, we:

• Secured a bike shelter and installed a scooter rack to promote greener travel.

The children have requested we raise money to fund a mindfulness shelter — a calm, outdoor space for children to use during breaks or for small group activities, whatever the weather.
