### Topic

We will then move on to our woodlands theme; we will be reading lots of different books including The Gruffalo and Where the Wild Things Are.

We will regularly send a Take Home sheet with your child to update you on topics we are covering. Acorns don't attend harvest along with the school, although you will be welcome to take your nursery age child with you to the performance if you wish. We will send information about things we are doing in school throughout the half term.

## **Reading Books**

Maple class will soon be coming home with reading books. These are books for you to share with your child, developing a love of reading and enjoying storytimes together. We would ask that books be returned **every Thursday** so that we can send home **new books on a Friday**. Please write in the yellow reading record when you have read together. Once we begin our phonics sessions; the children will eventually bring home reading books to practice their phonics reading skills.

Acorn class will also bring home a book to share at home. We will get our book box out on a Monday and Friday (allowing for the different days the Nursery children are in) and children can change it each week.
