Reading

English: The children are making good progress through daily phonics using Read Write Inc. All have made good progress in the sounds they have learned and are ready for the upcoming phonics screening test. This will take place from the 12th to 16th June.

This term we have begun to read Little Red Riding Hood by Lari Don. We have been using the book to help us continue to teach children how to use capital letters, full stops, finger spaces and to spell using their phonic knowledge, as well as write for different purposes. We will continue to do lots of fine motor skills activities to develop their handwriting skills.

Maths:

We will be doing lots of:

- Numbers to 100
- Telling time to the hour and half hour
- Money-recognising coins and notes
- Volume and Capacity
- Finding and Comparing Mass
- Describing positions and turns
