Who was Mary Seacole?	Mary Seacole was a nurse . Her mother was Jamaican and her father was Scottish. She travelled from Jamaica to look after wounded soldiers on the battlefield in the Crimean War . She set up a hospital called the British Hotel to look after soldiers .
Who was Florence Nightingale?Florence Nightingale was a nurse. She made hospitals cleaner for patients of looked after soldiers in the Crimean War. She set up the Nightingale Trainin School for nurses in 1860.	
Who was Edith Cavell?Edith Cavell was a nurse in the First World War. She saved soldiers from bWho was Edith Cavell?sides during the First World War. Edith helped over 200 soldiers escape from bGerman army.German army.
