

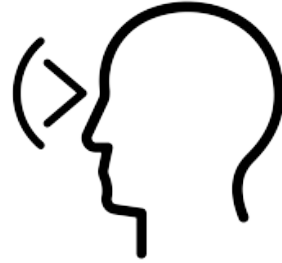

8 words and meanings to learn

Key Word	Meaning
sight	One of the five senses. We use our eyes to see.
taste	One of the five senses. Taste is picked up using your tongue.
touch	Allows you to tell if something is hot or cold, dull or sharp, rough or smooth, wet or dry.
sound	Anything that can be heard.
hear	We receive sound with our ears.
noise	A sound is a type of noise.
trumpet	A brass instrument used to make music.
eye	What we see through.

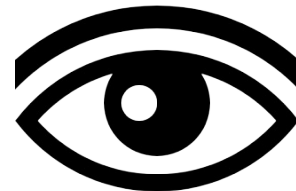
