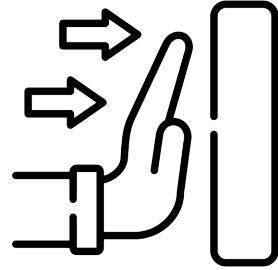

### 8 words and meanings to learn

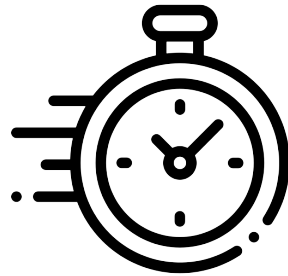
Key Word	Meaning

float	The opposite of sink. A boat floats.
press	To push down on a surface.
suck	You suck your drink through a straw.



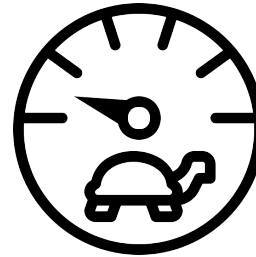
