Reading Books

Please ensure your child reads to an adult every day, even if your child is a confident reader, this will really support their reading stamina, fluency and comprehension. Your child needs to bring their reading book and reading record into school every day. Please ensure you sign your child's reading record each time you listen to them read. Your child needs to read for 10 minutes every school night to make good progress. It is also in the school's homework policy and home school agreement.

Water

We encourage children to drink water during the school day. Water should be brought from home each morning in a bottle labelled with your child's name. From experience, we know that children will drink water, if they are thirsty, even if they prefer the flavour of squash.

<u>PE</u>

Year 4 will be swimming on <u>Tuesday mornings</u> for the whole school year. P.E. lessons will take place on a <u>Monday afternoon</u>. Children should bring their P.E kit to <u>leave in school</u> as they will get changed in school once again.

As the weather can be unpredictable at this time of year, please make sure your child has an appropriate P.E. kit (plain black shorts and a plain white t-shirt for inside and plain black jogging bottoms and a plain white t-shirt with a plain black sweatshirt for outside). Please make sure children bring a pair of **trainers**.

The children will be using spelling shed to support their learning of spellings and will practise their handwriting regularly over the week.
