Children continue to read both independently and in whole class or small groups. We use <u>Reading VIPERS</u> in our guided reading lessons to help us answer a variety of comprehension questions.

Times tables

The children should be familiar with 1, 2, 3, 5, and 10 times tables and we are continuing to work on the 4 and 8 times tables. Please support your child in doing this at least 3 times per week.

Spellings

Spellings will be given out each Monday. Children can use spelling shed to practice spellings at home. They will have a weekly spelling test the following Monday.
