

Unit CL2.2 How do people express their spirituality?



Prior learning – Key stage one

The concept of spirituality is new to LKS2.

In KS1 pupils will have learned how people celebrate special events and how and why people pray.

Celebration and prayer can be linked to how people express spirituality.

How can you show what you believe?

What do symbols tell us about beliefs?

How do Christians use visual arts to express beliefs?

How do Muslims use calligraphy and pattern to express beliefs?

How do religions use words as an art form to express beliefs?

How are different individuals and communities inspired by music?

How can dance express faith?

Transferable Question

How do people express their deepest feelings?

Key Learning

Pupils explain their understanding of 'spiritual' and explain some ideas and beliefs that are important to them.

They discuss how some Christians express their beliefs using visual imagery. They recognise that Muslims use other forms of art, such as pattern, instead of images. Pupils explore how words and poetry, music and dance are used by some faiths as an art form and to express beliefs.
