Key Learning

Pupils will explore the importance of the Bible for Christians – what it is and how it helps Christians to live their lives. Pupils will explore Jesus' teachings about rules and behaviour in relation to a variety of Bible stories and parables. These stories influence individuals and communities. Pupils reflect on, analyse and evaluate their own beliefs and what it means to lead a good life.
